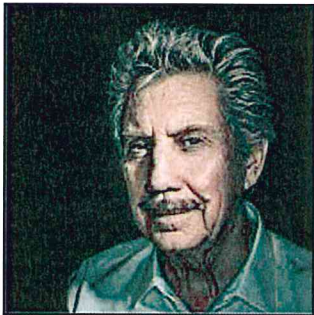




## Robert Thomas Bigelow Class of 1962

Robert Thomas Bigelow, 76 is a native of Las Vegas, Nevada. Married to Diane Mona Bigelow for 55 years until her passing in 2020. Together they had 2 children and 2 grandchildren.



### **Experience**

Since the beginning of his career in real estate, the scope of Robert Bigelow's business endeavors has included ownership of banking operations, real estate acquisitions, sales, real estate brokerage, design, development, financing, general contracting and management of many thousands of apartments in 5 southwestern states including the extended stay hotel chain Budget Suites of America. He also founded Bigelow Aerospace, Bigelow Institute for Consciousness Studies and The Robert T. Bigelow Charitable Institute both in 2020.

### **Bigelow Management Inc. (BMI) became Your Best Management Group (YBMG) Owner/President/CEO**

Currently, YBMG, functions as the management company for approximately 7,160 apartments.

### **Bigelow Development Corp. Owner/President/Licensee**

Bigelow Development Corporation as general contractor has developed and constructed approximately 15,000 units over the years, purchased 8,000 apartments, and additionally other project types.

## **Bigelow Aerospace, LLC**

### **Owner/President/Operating Manager**

In 1999, he founded Bigelow Aerospace (“BA”). BA is a general contracting, investment, research and development company that concentrates on achieving economic breakthroughs in the costs associated with the design, development and construction of habitable space stations, space transportation and launch facilities to the extent that they will be affordable for private enterprise use. BA was temporarily closed by the Covid 19 mandate by Governor Sisolak in 2020.

Bigelow Aerospace has launched two experimental space modules, Genesis I in 2006 and Genesis II in 2007, and had planned for full-scale space habitats to be used as orbital hotels, research labs and factories.

In April 2016, Bigelow's BEAM module, the only privately owned module on the ISS, was launched to the International Space Station on the eighth SpaceX cargo resupply mission.

In December, 2017, Bigelow was reported by the New York Times to have urged Senator Harry Reid to initiate what became the Advanced Aerospace Threat Identification Program, a government study of UFO's.

## **Bigelow Institute for Consciousness Studies**

### **Owner/Founder/CEO**

In June 2020 he founded Bigelow Institute for Consciousness Studies “BICS” to support research into both the survival of human consciousness after physical death and, based on data from such studies, the nature of the afterlife. For decades he has also supported serious investigations into consciousness and manifestations of unusual phenomena that are not yet understood by science.

Despite intriguing evidence, the number of research groups and funding devoted to investigating the survival of human consciousness beyond death is shockingly small in the Western world. Even though all 7.8 billion humans on planet Earth will eventually die, very little high quality research is being conducted on perhaps the most important and fundamental question facing our species.

One purpose of the BICS is to raise awareness among the public and within the scientific community of the importance and relevance of such an investigation. BICS hopes to provide a public service by drawing increasing attention to, and encouraging research into, this fundamental and timeless topic. BICS is seeking hard evidence “beyond a reasonable doubt” that takes us beyond religion or philosophy and provides a body of knowledge to be brought widely into the public arena that could be partially unifying in its impact on human awareness and culture. Now BICS is offering \$1.5 million in prizes for the best evidence for “the survival of consciousness after permanent bodily death.”

## **Robert T. Bigelow Charitable Institute**

### **Owner/Founder/CEO**

He supports many charities such as the Make-a-Wish Foundation, Shade Tree, Salvation Army, Smile Train, Boys Town of Nevada, The Las Vegas Rescue Mission, Three Square, M.D. Anderson Cancer Institute, St Jude Hospital, The Lou Ruvo Brain Center, a variety of family tragedy victims, and St Rose Dominican Health Foundation locally.

Robert Bigelow graduated from Arizona State University with a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration majoring in real estate and banking. In addition, over the years, he has completed many post-graduate business courses.
