



After high school, I joined the U.S. Air Force in August of 1976. After Basic Training I was stationed at Castle Air Force Base near Merced, CA as a Communications Specialist. Jill Schaefer and I were married in December of 1976. We were blessed with a daughter in August, 1978. I took a hardship discharge and moved back to Las Vegas to be with my family at the end of '78. Back in Las Vegas, I started working for Purolator Armored Inc. as an Armored Car Driver in early 1979. Jill and I were divorced in 1981 but I still have a very close relationship with my daughter.

One day, while on my bank route I ran into Debbie Tuderios. We went out and our friendship quickly turned into a relationship and we were married in 1983.

When we married, I was working for the State of Nevada, Department of Prisons in Indian Springs as a Corrections Officer. The drive was too long so I went to work for the City of Las Vegas Dept. of Detention at the City Jail in 1984. In 1991 Deb was offered an Escrow Officer position in Lincoln, Nebraska so she and I, and her 2 kids, moved to Lincoln at the end of December that year. It was a very big adjustment and culture shock for us all. It seemed as if we had gone back in time. I started working for Emergency Co

When Deb's kids graduated and started their lives, we decided to move back to the west (no mountains in Nebraska!}. In February 2000 I was hired by the Washoe County Sheriff's Office to manage the Incline Village 9-1-1/Dispatch Center. In 2002 an opportunity arose and I was hired by Douglas County Emergency Communications/9-1-1 as a Supervisor. I have since taken over as the County's Animal Control Supervisor, which has been quite an experience, at least most these inmates' bark is worse than their bite. We try not to euthanize the animals (dogs & cats), so we have them longer at our shelter than most shelters would keep them. I still work part-time in Incline Village as a Deputy Constable.

We now live in the Carson Valley and are enjoying the area and the beautiful Sierra Nevada Mountains' scenery. We have 3 beautiful grandchildren, one from each child and are looking forward to our newest grandchild in August from my daughter.
