NOTABLE ALUMNI CORNER . . .

ROBERT STOLDAL (Class of 1961)



Bob Stoldal graduated from LVHS in 1961. While at LVHS he was the Student Librarian and wrote for the Desert Breeze newspaper. He attended UNLV (where he was the editor of the student newspaper), and also took classes at Notre Dame and Belmont University.

Bob was born in San Francisco and worked as an apprentice in a butcher shop after school and on weekends from age 12 to 15, although he wanted to become a librarian. He was drawn into the news business as a teenage reporter for KSPO radio in San Francisco. Soon he was printing his own neighborhood newsletter. His family moved to Las Vegas in 1957. While a student at LVHS, Bob worked nights and weekends as a busboy at the Stardust, Dunes and Riviera hotels. After graduating from LVHS, Bob spent the next summer and winter cleaning the floors and washing dishes for his board and keep. Next up for Bob was another sweeping job - this time in the backroom of the Las Vegas Review Journal. He was paid to sweep up the lead from the machines that produced the type and melt the

lead to be used again. In addition to sweeping the floors he was trained to hand set captions on stories and the headline to the newspaper.

Then in 1961, because of his deep voice, Stoldal was hired as the graveyard shift DJ at KLAS radio, going by the name of Bob Free, and read news off the teletype. In 1966 he moved to what is now KTNV Channel 13 as a part-time sports reporter and weatherman. In 1967 he was hired as a reporter and anchor at KLAS-TV, Channel 8, when Hank Greenspun owned the Las Vegas Sun and the television station. In addition to reporting and anchoring, Stoldal was promoted to oversee the entire news operation as News Director in 1968. That same year Howard Hughes purchased KLAS-TV. During his tenure as News Director, United Press International honored KLAS as "Best Newscast in America". As News Director, Bob led the fight in Southern Nevada to allow television cameras in courtrooms. He broadcast the first criminal trial in Nevada and also produced the first live coverage of pleadings before the Nevada Supreme Court in Carson City in 2002. In 1992, Bob was asked to expand the news operation at a newly acquired CBS affiliate in Nashville, TN. He also launched three 24-hour regional all-news cable channels – in Virginia, Tennessee and Las Vegas. He delivered the first one-hour nightly local news program in Nevada, and in 1998 launched Las Vegas ONE as a 24-hour local news TV operation, owned by Cox Cable, KLAS and the Las Vegas Sun. He was promoted to Vice President of News for KLAS, overseeing the news operations at KLAS as well as Las Vegas ONE and Las Vegas Now, the KLAS website.

At age 65, Bob retired from KLAS in 2007 and focused his attention on the history of Nevada and Las Vegas through writing and support of several history organizations. In 2009 he returned to work as Executive Vice President of News for Sunbelt Communications (Channel 3) where he was responsible for outlets in Las Vegas, Reno and Elko. While at Channel 3 he expanded the daily news program by 3½ hours. A few weeks after turning 71 years old, Bob retired again, in November, 2014.

Bob is a member of the Nevada Broadcasting Hall of Fame. He is Chairman of the Nevada State Museum and Historical Society and a member of the Las Vegas Historic Preservation Commission. The latter opened the Las Vegas Law Enforcement and Organized Crime Museum, commonly referred to as the "Mob Museum" in 2010 in the historic downtown post office on Stewart Street. He is also Vice Chairman of the Nevada Cultural Affairs Commission, a member of the Nevada Commission on Tourism, a member of the KNPR Community Advisory board, a member of the Las Vegas Centennial Commission board, a member of the Atomic Testing Museum board, Vice Chairman and Charter Board Member of Preserve Nevada and a board member of the Las Vegas Springs Preserve, among many additional organizations. Bob and his wife Kay have four sons. His dedication and efforts towards preservation of Las Vegas and Nevada history are endless. We are proud to have him as a lifetime member of the Las Vegas High School Alumni Association!

Seems as we get older, places, events and friends from our past become more important. Growing up in Las Vegas, cruising Fremont, our old hangouts, and LVHS have become topics of discussion with my old friends.

A little over six years ago, a group of LVHS grads decided to form an alumni association to not only preserve the old building downtown, but to help future graduates attain their goals and provide assistance to the needs of the new campus. Our association has now grown to almost 450 members. That seems like a lot, but not when you consider all the classes that have graduated from the old and new campuses. (I use the phrase "new campus", but it is now over 20 years old!)


