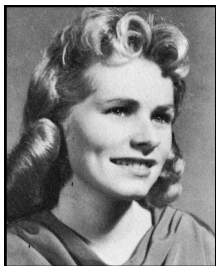

NOTABLE ALUMNI CORNER . . .

LINDA RANKIN GIVENS (Class of 1958)



Linda and her family moved to Las Vegas in 1954. She was involved in a lot of activities during her years at LVHS. She was on the Desert Breeze newspaper staff, on Student Council for three years, Sophomore Class Treasurer, was a delegate to Girls' State, was selected outstanding girl at graduation, and was the 1958 Senior Class Vice President. She received her Bachelor of Arts degree in 1962 from Arizona State University (where she was selected Outstanding Freshman Woman, homecoming queen, and was selected to Who's Who in American Universities) and her Master of Science degree in Reading in 1987 from Nova University. She began teaching for the Clark

County School District in 1963, and her 30-year career saw her at five elementary schools in Las Vegas. She taught mostly kindergarten and first and second grade students. At one school, she was assigned to teach fourth grade, which caused her to panic. "I'm under 5 feet tall - the kids will all be bigger than me" she said. She ended up hitting the playground at recess to play tether ball and softball alongside her students. She had a good time that year but went back to teaching kindergarten the next year! Linda has two children - Michelle who also became a teacher, and Mike, a certified public accountant. She also has nine grandchildren who are a delight in her life. Linda says she loved teaching elementary school and being the first one to teach the children and watch them grow. She says "with kindergarten, you can honestly see them change, every day, every week. They learn so much." Linda was involved with the project for the trophies now on display at the cafeteria at the "new" LVHS. The Linda Rankin Givens Elementary School was named after her and opened in 2004. Even though she retired in 1993, the school sees a lot of Linda. She tries to be there for every function and event, including assemblies. It's been said that the kids look at her like she's a celebrity and that she is embedded into the fabric of the school and is not just a name on the side of the building. Since it opened, she visits the school every Friday and hosts "Story and Snack with Mrs. Givens". Linda also has done a lot of volunteer work in Las Vegas, including the Junior League and the Assistance League, and serving on a lot of education boards. She was awarded the Junior League Lifetime Community Achievement Award in 2016. Her hobbies include golf and bridge.

RESTORATION AND PRESERVATION OF THE "OLD" LAS VEGAS HIGH SCHOOL CAMPUS (NOW THE LAS VEGAS ACADEMY)

Restoration and preservation of the "old" campus of Las Vegas High School (LVHS) has been on the minds of many of us alumni.

Senator Richard Bryan (1955) and Las Vegas Councilman (and former Nevada State Senator) Bob Coffin were instrumental in the placement of the LVHS main building and gymnasium on the National Register of Historical Places in 1986. The identification as a historical building does not come with any source of funding for it's restoration and preservation costs. These costs are typically borne by the local community and to date none have been allocated by the Clark County School District (CCSD).



Several discussions have occurred with Scott Walker, Principal of the Las Vegas Academy and others, but no clear path for funding of the restoration has surfaced. During some of these discussions, we were informed, it is the intent of CCSD to build a new Las Vegas Academy building on the existing campus which will necessitate the demolition of some of the older and less useful structures.

Senator Bryan is now spearheading the search for restoration funding which resulted in the attendance of Blake Cumbers, Senior VP of construction and utilization of all schools in CCSD, at the January board meeting of the LVHS Alumni Association. Mr. Cumbers informed us that there is no current plan to update or remediate any issues that may exist in the older buildings.

Shortly thereafter, Senator Bryan scheduled a meeting with a senior Trustee of CCSD, for he and myself. After some discussion, the Trustee expressed strong support for the preservation of the school and for funding an architectural study and assessment which would include recommendations and cost estimates for the remediation work. During this meeting, it was suggested that we attend the Bond Oversight Committee Meeting, two days thereafter, to familiarize ourselves with the process CCSD must observe for any capital funding.

Senator Bryan was unable to attend, but I represented LVHSAA at the Bond Oversight Committee Meeting. Near the end of the meeting I was able to address the committee. I identified myself as an officer of LVHSAA and gave a brief outline of the size of our organization and benefits we provide to the current students of LVHS. I told them I was attending to observe the process that is undertaken for them to consider the capitol expenditure of a study and for the ultimate restoration of several buildings of the original LVHS campus. I was warmly treated by the committee during my presentation. After the adjournment of the meeting I was approached by two of the committee members who pledged support for the restoration. One of the members graduated from the original LVHS campus as well as her sisters, cousins and father.

I have reached out to an architect Senator Bryan and I both have confidence in who indicated that there is no company here in Las Vegas that is qualified to perform the appropriate assessment, because we don't have many old structures, we simply 'blow them up!' Senator Bryan and many others want the highest priority of these preservation efforts to be targeted toward the main building and the gymnasium. I have contacted this architectural firm and we will work toward funding the assessment and restoration of these two buildings. I will follow these actions and keep everyone up to date with the progress of the restoration, preservation and continued use of the Las Vegas High School (Academy) and gymnasium buildings.

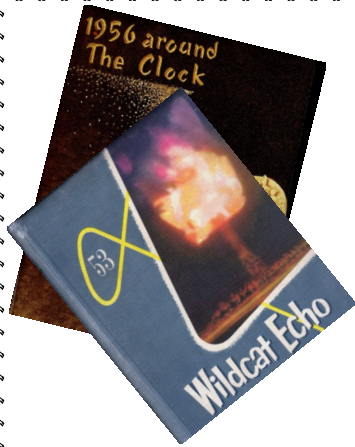
CALLING ALL WILDCATS FROM CLASSES OF 1951 THROUGH 1955

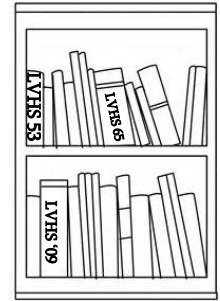
YEARBOOKS

WE'VE COME A LONG WAY, BABY!

When a small group of LVHS graduates started the LVHS Alumni Association, our primary mission was to help provide scholarship money to graduating seniors who were planning on furthering their education in Southern Nevada. Initially, I'm not sure that we knew what we were doing; and, I'm not sure that the principal and faculty had much confidence in us either. It's been almost 10 years now, and we have not only gained a lot of members, but we have also gained the respect of the principal and staff. Our mission has broadened. By the end of this year, we will have awarded almost \$100,000 in scholarships. We have also provided bus passes for students, supplies for teachers and classrooms, and participated in school events like Homecoming. We help homeless and needy students, maintain our Senior Squares monument, and have a vehicle donation program where we recondition cars, trucks, motor homes, etc. and sell them. All the money goes into our scholarship program. This year, we hope to get involved in the preservation of the old campus.

All this has been done with a small, dedicated board of directors, many of whom have been there since its inception. We have recently gained new board members with fresh ideas. Some of the new members already have a close relationship to the high school, and others have exciting ideas about how to generate fresh interest and new fundraising means to increase our scholarships and provide more help to the school. We are even looking into grant writing. This year, for example, we are also planning an art auction at the Springs Preserves to raise funds.

Having said all that, we are always looking for new board members who bring innovative ideas and abilities. If you are interested in becoming a member of our board, please contact one of our members, or attend one of our board meetings. Our board meets approximately eight times a year. All LVHSAA members are welcome to attend. Our meeting dates and details are posted on the "Association News" page of our website. If you are a member of the LVHSAA, and have friends who are LVHS graduates, but not members, ask them why not, tell them about all we do, and ask them to join. They won't be sorry.

In closing, let me say that this year, for the first time, we entered our Wildcat float in the Veterans Day Parade. We invited former graduates to ride or walk alongside the float. The LVHS Cheerleaders were there, and Federal Judge Lloyd George (1948) was our Grand Marshall. The parade was a very emotional experience, especially for those of us who are veterans.
