This year will mark the 11th year that the LVHSAA has been in existence. Since inception, we have provided many scholarships and much support to the students and staff of LVHS. ## MEET OUR LVHSAA HISTORIAN . . .

### JOE THOMSON (Honorary Lifetime LVHSAA Member)



We first met Joe when he attended our Wildcat Reunions when they were still being held at Sam's Town. As a Historian, he came every year because he was interested in meeting and talking with a lot of our alumni and learning more about Las Vegas history. When the LVHSAA needed an Historian in 2013, Joe volunteered to help us out, even though he is not an LVHS alum. He has been attending our board meetings and assisting our board ever since. Joe has many talents! He is a great photographer and takes lots of photos at all of our events, plus he personally hand-built the beautiful display case which the LVHSAA donated to the Las Vegas Academy to house LVHS memorabilia.

**The following was written by Joe:** A few years back when I began to gather historical material concerning historic Las Vegas, I continued to run across a familiar thread. It seemed to be that the majority of the people I was working with all had a connection to Las Vegas High School. I was blessed to cross paths with early graduates Ed Von Tobel Jr. (1930), Katherine Tisdial (1939), Violet Oppedyk (1928), instructor Joe Thiriot, and others through a connection with Jean Sherman (1949). These individuals introduced me to a version of Las Vegas that was very intriguing.

Las Vegas was not new to me. I was born and raised among conversations of gambling and obsessive growth although the small-town version expressed by the Las Vegas High School folks was a refreshing change of pace. Their stories became intertwined within my research which is expressed through a combination of my two distinct areas of focus. My undergraduate studies at UNLV were based in art and architecture as a sculptor, photographer, and painter with a minor in art history that I forwarded to graduate studies in the field of the history of the North American West. The relatable directive of this is a focus into the history of early Las Vegas of which photography plays a central role.

These interactions with the Las Vegas High School folks would culminate in them embracing me as the historian for their alumni association. My own high school experience took place at Las Vegas High School's younger brother to the west, Western High School. Albeit for the terms of my research the land that would embrace Western was decades from development. The friendships found within the ranks of the Las Vegas High School Alumni Association clan are of a cherished sort that I have collaborated with on numerous projects.

Included in the collective of collaborations is a venture shared with LVHS alumni Rollie Gibbs and Dave Williams known as *Pioneering Las Vegas History*. PLVH meets for a luncheon event at the Nevada State Museum the second Tuesday every month at 11:30 for a program that discusses a contributing subject of interest. These historical events have included several with ties to Las Vegas High School including, the Wildcat Lair, the Rhythmettes, the preservation of Las Vegas High School and a celebration of the 60th anniversary of the 1953 State Championship football team. Please consider joining us for future discussions with the PLVH group, inclusive of an event on March 12 that welcomes Las Vegas High School alum Bill Boyd (1949), Executive Chairman and co-founder of Boyd Gaming Company.

## KEEPING UP WITH OUR SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

It's always interesting to hear how our scholarship recipients have done since leaving LVHS. Here's an update from a 2013 recipient:



**Javier Aget-Torres** (class of 2013) was his Class President. He is now 23 years old and received a Bachelor's from UNLV in Psychology and Marriage & Family Therapy, graduating in the class of 2017. He then returned to UNLV to take nursing prerequisite courses to get into a nursing program (Microbiology, Human Anatomy & Physiology, Nutrition, etc.). When we heard from him in early 2018, he was working as a Case Manager for the Boys & Girls Clubs where he was helping low-income families, and was in his last two prerequisites and had been accepted to Columbia University in New York to pursue a Masters of Nursing and Doctorate of Nursing Practice in Psychiatric Mental Health Nursing.

After graduating the four year Masters to Doctorate combined program, he will be working as a Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner in Las Vegas. He hopes to one day open his own clinic and provide medication management and mental health services for at-risk populations such as low income families, LGBT folks, ethnic minorities and disabled veterans.

A longtime Wildcat, Debbie first joined the staff at LVHS in 1998 as a Special Education Facilitator, where she worked hands-on with a broad spectrum of students. Recognized almost immediately for her exceptional skills by former Principal Barry Gunderson, Debbie soon assumed a leadership role as Dean of Students and less than one year later, was appointed the position of Assistant Principal over curriculum and testing. "Thank you, Mrs. Brockett" soon became the mantra for thousands of students as she created new and innovative programs and after-school tutoring sessions and classes, continually thinking outside the box to ensure the success of all students. Getting to know her students brought both pride and joy and also gave Debbie the ability to challenge each and every one of them to reach ever higher. 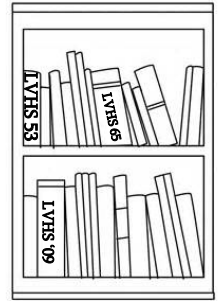

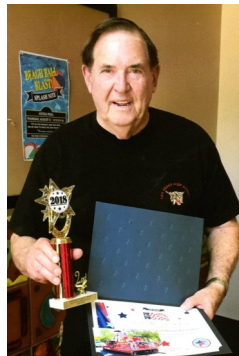
2018 Summerlin Patriotic Parade

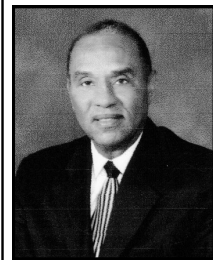
