We are now in our 13th year, and thanks to the support of LVHS alumni, last year was our best year yet! During 2019, we provided \$7900 in grants to LVHS students for things such as course fees, AP exams, dual credit tuitions, STUCO Packs, Chromebooks presented to less fortunate students at Senior Awards night, Thanksgiving food, caps and gowns, bus passes, and yearbooks for less fortunate students. We also helped send students to the Close-Up Program and Drum & Bugle Corps. All of this is in addition to awarding scholarships totaling \$20,000 to 9 graduating students. We held a joint fundraiser with the Las Vegas Academy in October and made almost \$12,000 for our scholarship fund. We sincerely thank you for your generous donations to our scholarship and grant programs. Your membership dues, donations, and participation in our fund raising efforts all help with these worthy causes. We have a lot going on this year and really need and appreciate your continued support!

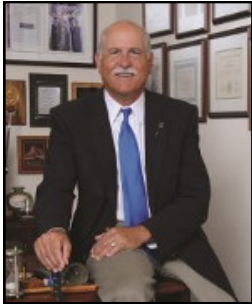

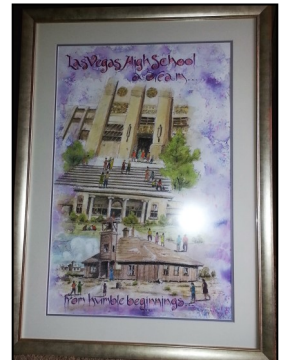

ALLEN KAERCHER - Class of 1968

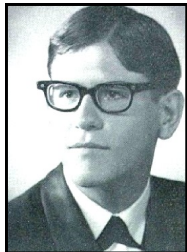


Hat's off to Allen and his fundraising committee! Allen has been a loyal Director of the Las Vegas High School Alumni Association for the last four years. Last year he came up with the idea of holding a joint fundraiser with the Las Vegas Academy (our "old" campus) to help the Academy raise funds toward beautification of the old auditorium on 9th and Clark, and to benefit the LVHSAA Scholarship Fund. The net proceeds would be split 50/50 with the Academy. Allen formed a committee consisting of board members Ronnie Blomgren Wilson (1969), Maria Konold (1981), Crystal Latham Beville (1981) and his wife Lisa. They worked with the Academy Principal Scott Walker and his assistant Jolene Mitchell. Plaques were sold for the "Legacy Wall" at the entrance of the auditorium and an event was held in the auditorium on



October 17 honoring Bill Boyd (1948), who presented the Academy an original painting by artist Roy Purcell, a well known artist, depicting the history of Las Vegas High School. A reception was held in an office across the street from the auditorium, with music provided by the LVA Jazz Quartet. The LVA Mariachi Band accompanied attendees to the auditorium, where LVA Pianist Natalie Burton provided music in the lobby. Speakers included Allen, Senator Richard Bryan (1955) and Bill Boyd. The program included dance routines by LVA's Male Dance Elective class members. It was a very enjoyable evening and made \$11,600 for the Academy and \$11,600 for our Scholarship Fund see photos on Page 4). Congratulations to Allen and his committee, and especially to Allen's wife Lisa for her hard work in making the fundraiser a success.

Allen was born and raised in Las Vegas. He is the President of Kaercher Insurance. Allen earned his Bachelor of Science degree in business insurance administration from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas. SCHOLARSHIPS

Since 2009, we have given \$131,000 in scholarships to a total of 68 students. This year, for the first time, we are offering 2nd year scholarships to our prior year's recipients. KEEPING UP WITH OUR SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

It's always interesting to hear how our scholarship recipients have done since leaving LVHS. Here are some recent updates:

Jefferzon Amezcua (2019) is taking Business Management and Nutrition Sciences and minoring in Entrepreneurship at UNLV. In spite of working in his family's business and another job 25-30 hours a week, he has maintained a 3.4 GPA in his first semester. He recently made the Honor Society. He plans to graduate in 2025 and to eventually take over his family's business. His advice to future graduates is choose a career from your deepest enjoyments in life and don't be afraid to chase after a career that is seen as unlikely or impossible.

Gabrielle Hage (2019) earned 13 credits in her first semester at UNLV. Her goal is to get a Bachelor's Degree in Nursing.

Britney Martinez (2019) earned 16 credits, achieved a 4.0 GPA and made the Dean's List in her first semester at UNLV. Her goal is elementary education.

Gabriella Montes (2019) is majoring in Biology and Minoring in Deaf Studies at Nevada State College with the goal of working in the medical field. She is working 20 hours a week and earned a 4.0 GPA in her first semester at NSC. Her advice to future graduates is to not rush high school and wish it over quickly. She still misses high school!

Ricardo Oseguera-Cardona (2017) is attending Nevada State College and plans to graduate in 2021. He is taking Business Administration and Pre-Law, with the goal of becoming a lawyer. He has been working 25-30 hours a week for the Cashier's Office, Student government and as a Peer Educator, mentoring first-gen college students. He advises future graduates to do the same and make on-campus connections and to open themselves up to opportunities early on.

Elizabeth Solis (2018) has been working in the Office of Admissions at UNLV for over a year. She works with programs that coordinate events and mentors students from elementary school to high school. She has also been an undergraduate teaching assistant in a biology lab. She is in a Pre-Nursing Program, with a goal of Neonatal Nursing. She plans to graduate in 2022. Her advice to future graduates is get involved early and don't be afraid to reach out for help or ask questions.

Angel Taylor (2019) achieved a 4.0 GPA and earned 16 credits in her first semester at UNLV and says someday she hopes to be able to give back to fellow Wildcats. Her goal is to get a Bachelor's Degree in Kinesiology in 2023 and then enroll in the UNLV Physical Therapist program.

Christopher Topacio (2019) took summer classes to get ahead so he can graduate in four years from a Civil Engineering program that normally takes 6-8 years. He was able to do this plus studying in the tutoring lab for many hours. He says he was only able to do this because of the help our scholarship provided so he didn't have to work while going to school. He made the Dean's Honors List of the College of Engineering. His goal is to graduate debt free.

LAS VEGAS HIGH SCHOOL HISTORIC ADVOCACY AWARD

LVHSAA was presented with the Las Vegas High School Historic Advocacy Award on 9/26/19 by Las Vegas Mayor Carolyn Goodman for their efforts toward the restoration and preservation of the original LVHS campus in downtown Las Vegas. Their preservation efforts resulted in a 17 million dollar commitment from the Clark County School District for restoration, preservation, and upgrading to the campus buildings.

GREAT ACCOMPLISHMENT!! LVA Legacy Update - Your alumni association at work!

HUGE ACCOMPLISHMENT!! Congratulations to LVHSAA Vice President Bruce Langson (class of 1965) who has spearheaded a project to preserve our old LVHS campus on 7th and Bridger (now the Las Vegas Academy). Bruce, along with alumni Senator Richard Bryan (1955) and Bob Stoldal (1961) have been working diligently on this project for the last few years. The Clark County School District recognized a need for \$15 million worth of renovation and upgrading to our campus. This came about from a \$46,000 architectural study that the LVHSAA commissioned. The \$46,000 came from a grant obtained by the LVHSAA from the Las Vegas Centennial Commission. The CCSD Bond Oversight Committee has now approved the \$15 million for the improvements, and added an additional \$4 million for emergency repairs. **Bravo for our campus, and of course our alumni!** Our buildings will need much more work to move them into their second hundred years of useful life and the continuation of wonderful traditions we enjoy. Bruce says that as he has strolled around the campus and chatted with the current LV Academy students, he is often "cornered" by them to answer questions about his school experience and growing up during that time. In every case, the current students of the Academy show a strong connection to our buildings and, even though their traditions may be different than ours, they love being on our campus and are joyful to be learning at our old campus, even with the small bathrooms and all of the inconveniences they endure each day. They love the campus and want to use and maintain the buildings.

YEARBOOKS



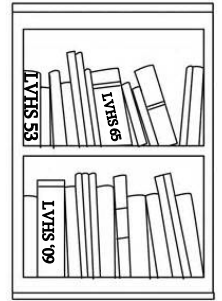

GLAD I DID! (by former LVHSAA board member Matt Shlisky, Class of 1964)

When a group of former LVHS graduates met at the old downtown campus 12 years ago, our mission was to minimize unmet social, economic and educational needs of the students of Las Vegas High School. One of our main goals was to help maintain and preserve the historic buildings on our old campus. One of the first things the group did was replace the Senior Squares with a permanent monumen. As the LVHSAA grew, it became more involved with the "new" LVHS students and staff by providing financial support, supplies, and a scholarship program, among other things. The group has also become more involved with the Las Vegas Academy, which now occupies the old LVHS campus.

I attended that first meeting in March, 2008, and shortly after, became a member of the board of directors of the LVHSAA. I became Scholarship Chairman and we helped provide funds for students who intended on furthering their education in Southern Nevada. I remained a board member for 9 years, and enjoyed all of it. Our board members had two goals in mind, the preservation of the old campus, and making the high school experience at LVHS a rich one.

When I left the board of directors, it was because I believed we needed new, younger members, more in tune with the needs of today's students in the way they are educated and communicate. I'm proud to see all the improvements the group has made. I'm also glad to see all the younger people who have become involved in taking up these tasks. Besides getting reacquainted with some old friends, it's a great way to make a positive difference in our growing community. It is very rewarding to know that you made a difference in the future of LVHS students!
