## 2011 WILDCAT REUNION What a Great Party!!

We were especially honored to have Violet Oppedyk Tracht (class of 1928), Lavetta Earl Butler (class of 1936), and Lina Pinjuv Sharp (class of 1937) in attendance!

The LVHS Marching Band kicked off the program, surprising everyone as they entered from both sides of the room playing the LVHS Fight Song. The LVHS cheerleaders added a special touch, giving out name badges and checking-in attendees, doing some special cheers and singing the Alma Mater along with the band. We were very happy to have the LVHS Assistant Principal, Student Council Advisor and 9 members of the Student Council in attendance.

The LVHS Rhythmettes were the honorees of the evening. We were pleased to have nearly 50 Rhythmettes in attendance, from the years of 1951 through 1981, including two of the original Rhythmettes (Betty Glover Gwillian, class of 1951 and Lynn Laird Rattinger, class of 1952). A great time was had by all and everyone is looking forward to the 2012 Wildcat Reunion!





#### **MEET BRUCE LANGSON (LVHS Class of 1965)**



Bruce has served as Vice President of the LVHS Alumni Association since it began in 2008. He has made significant contributions to the LVHSAA. He is the **designer** (and builder - with the help of numerous other alumni) of the Wildcat float! He is in charge of the Mentoring, Vehicle Donation and Grant programs for the LVHSAA and was honored as "Alumni of the Year" the 2011 Wildcat Reunion.

Bruce was born in Montebello, California and is married (for 42 years!) to Cathy J. Davis. They have two children, a son, Ryan, and a daughter, Nicole, plus five grandchildren. Bruce was part of a family whose goals were directed primarily toward construction and real estate development. He continuously remained active in that family business from 1967 to present while also creating his own construction and development/management companies. His

grandfather and father were general contractors and developers in California, Nevada and Texas. Bruce is also a general contractor and has assisted and been in charge of the design, building, operations, and management of various types of commercial properties that the family business developed and built. Those projects include multi-family, single family and town-home developments, commercial and industrial properties. He currently owns, manages and/or has built apartment complexes in Northern and Southern Nevada.

Bruce was granted a patent in 1987 for his original idea concerning the manufacture of photocopy exact duplication of artificial rock formations. The results are used in hotels, amusement parks, zoos, and other areas throughout the world that require realistic rock and water features. As a contractor or consultant, he has designed and/or built award winning naturalistic exhibits and water features around the globe. Bruce was recently granted two patents concerning the RV industry. He has served on American Concrete Institute's (ACI) Committees for 15 years. His reputation through the ACI and The Gunite Company has led to the demand of his consultation services from numerous owners and contractors, primarily assisting them in avoiding or overcoming problems that they encounter in their construction projects. 




#### ARE YOU LOOKING FOR A SPECIAL LVHS YEARBOOKS??

**Evelyn Tudor Roberts** – sent us a photo of herself taken May 27, 1936 in front of one of the Las Vegas Grammar School "tent school" buildings. The original Las Vegas High School building on 4<sup>th</sup> Street between Lewis and Clark Streets, had been converted to 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades when the new LVHS opened in 1930 at 7<sup>th</sup> and Bridger. It was wwswaburned down in May, 1934 and tents were used for classrooms until the new 5<sup>th</sup> Street School opened in late 1936. She was 11 years old and in the 5<sup>th</sup> grade when the photo was taken. She said it was very hot in the school, but they survived!
