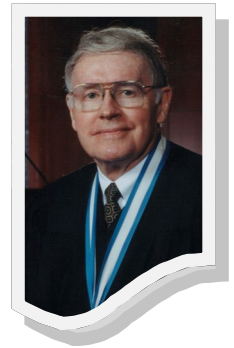
NOTABLE ALUMNI CORNER . . .

MEET JUDGE LLOYD D. GEORGE (Class of 1948)



Born in Montpelier, Idaho, Lloyd (“L. D.”) George was raised in Las Vegas. He was the Student Body President and graduated from Las Vegas High School in 1948.

He was a pilot in the U. S. Air Force. He received his Bachelor of Science degree in 1955 from Brigham Young University (and was the Student Body President there in 1955), and his J. D. degree in 1961 from the University of California at Berkeley. Upon graduating, he returned to Las Vegas where he had a successful private practice from 1961 to 1974, and was also a Justice of the Peace for Clark County from 1962 to 1969.



In 1974, Judge George was appointed to the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Nevada. During his ten years of service as a bankruptcy judge, he served on and was instrumental in the creation of bankruptcy appellate panels which permit panels of three bankruptcy judges to hear appeals directly from bankruptcy courts.

Judge George was appointed to United States District Judge for the District of Nevada by President Ronald Reagan in May, 1984. He served as Chief U. S. District Judge from 1992 to 1997, and assumed senior status in December, 1997.

In 1996, he was selected to represent the Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit as a member of the Judicial Conference of the United States, the national policy-making and management body of the federal judiciary. That year he was appointed to the Conference’s Executive Committee. Prior to his appointment to the Judicial Conference, he served for a number of years on three Judicial Conference committees and was the chair of two.

Judge George has distinguished himself as an expert in the organization of the judiciary. He has participated in numerous seminars and lectured on constitutional issues and court structure in Eastern Europe and the nations of the former Soviet Union. In 1996 he chaired a committee that worked to update the long-range national plan for the judiciary. He has also been a board member of the Federal Judicial Center (the education arm of the federal judiciary) where he served for four years with Chief Justice Warren Burger.

Judge George has authored articles on the administration of the federal judiciary, ethics and insolvency. He has won many awards, including the BYU Alumni Distinguished Service Award, the Notre Dame Club’s John C. Mowbray Humanitarian of the Year Award, and the Boy Scouts of America Silver Beaver Award. At the commencement at BYU in 2001, Judge George was the recipient of the Presidential Citation. In 2005, he received the Jensen Public Service Award from Boalt Hall, University of California.



The Lloyd D. George United States Courthouse in Las Vegas, completed in July, 2000, is named in his honor.

Judge George is a lifetime member of the LVHSAA. The LVHSAA is honored to have had Judge George as the “Notable Alumni” riding on our Wildcat Float in several Hellsdorado Parades!

2012 WILDCAT REUNION

The 2012 Wildcat Reunion, held on September 15, was a big success. We had nearly 500 attendees from classes of 1936 through 2012 - a 76 year span! They came from all corners of the U.S., from Maine to Texas, to Washington State, to Hawaii, plus one from Mexico!! The new venue was great, with lots of room to move between tables - especially for those with walkers or wheelchairs. And everyone had an opportunity to have their photo taken with the LVHS Wildcat mascot! We were assisted at the check-in tables by 12 delightful LVHS cheerleaders (in uniform!).

The event was in honor of all LVHS marching bands, and started with an enthusiastic kick off with the LVHS marching band (all 104 members) and cheerleaders breaking through a large LVHS sign (made by the cheerleaders) as they played the LVHS Fight Song. Led by Band Director Dr. William Woodworth, they stopped, circling the entire ballroom and down the center of the room, and played a couple of numbers, including the Alma Mater, followed by the cheerleaders leading us in a few cheers! There were nearly 50 former LVHS band members in attendance.

The second way is to make a donation of at least \$5000 into the LVHS Memorial Scholarship fund and be listed as a donor to the fund.

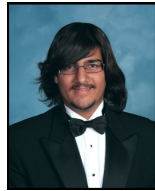

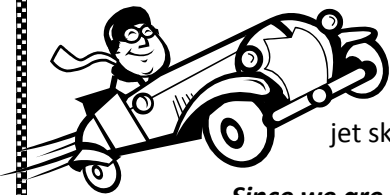
2013 HELLDORADO PARADE
