

### **2015 WILDCAT REUNION**

The 2015 Wildcat Reunion was a grand success! If you didn't attend, you missed a really great time!! We had a total of 580 attendees and they came from all corners of the continental U.S. (including Arizona, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Florida, Idaho, Iowa, Kansas, Maine, Minnesota, Montana, New Mexico, North Carolina, Oregon, Texas, Utah and Washington) plus Hawaii. **Robert Martin**, class of 1965, received the

award for traveling the furthest – coming from China! We had attendees from classes of 1937 through 2015 – a 78 year span! Our oldest attendees were Lina Pinjuv Sharp (class of 1937) and Nancy Marriott Austin (class of 1939). Our youngest attendees were four of our scholarship winners from 2015 (Alex Blake, Sherwin Cadiao, Angelee Santaren and Brittany Serano). We also had an attendee from class of 2005 and several from 2006 who are now LVHS faculty! Our DJ, Brian Mesaric, is from the class of 2003. We honored the classes of 1940 through 1945 and had 21 alumni attendees from those classes. We were pleased to have more from the 70s and after, than in previous years. We hope to have even more next year once the word gets around about what a good time everyone had, how great the food was and how much fun the younger crowd had dancing!

Congratulations to the class of 1965, celebrating their 50<sup>th</sup> reunion. They had the most attendees – a total of 104! Class of 1955, celebrating their 60<sup>th</sup> reunion, had the second highest attendance, and class of 1964 came in third! Class of 1965 won our Membership Challenge, having the most LVHSAA members (with 13 new members joining the LVHSAA at the reunion). were presented the "Outstanding Alumni of the Year" award for their on-going support and help over the years. This year Donna was very instrumental in helping develop information for our printed program.



### DONNA JO HANLEY ANDRESS and CLYDE GAIL ANDRESS have been married for 71 years and both turned 90 this



year! Donna's mother was Clarabelle Hanley, a long-time teacher at the 5th Street Grammar School and Librarian at LVHS. Donna was LVHS Student Body Secretary until she participated in Senior Ditch Day! She attended University of Nevada, Reno and is a 70 year member of Kappa Alpha Theta. Gail dropped out of his last year at LVHS to join the U.S. Navy. He was a TBF gunner during WWII and did submarine patrol between Florida and Cuba. After the war he managed the C. C. McDaniel Chrysler-Plymouth dealership (owned by his grandfather) in Las Vegas. He later started his own construction business. Donna worked on and off for the Las Vegas



Sun from the 1950s through the early 1980s. She co-wrote the multi-part series "Las Vegas High School: Its People, Its Impact" in 1980. Both Donna and Gail have been very active in community service. Donna is a 60 year member of the Service/Junior League, and is a member of the Morelli House Committee 2015. Both are active volunteers for Mojave

Desert Heritage and Cultural Association and Gail has done all their backhoe work for over 18 years. Donna is a founding member of Great Basin National Park Foundation, founding member of Natural Science Scholarship Association, UNLV. They square-danced for 40 years and Gail was Co-Chairman of the B-Sharp Square Dance Club. Gail drove stock cars at the Silver Slipper Racetrack and also attended a Sturgis Motorcycle Rally, surrounded by Harleys, on his Goldwing! When they were in their 70s they hiked the Grand Canyon, from the north to the south rim! They have two children, 3 grandchildren and 7 great-grandchildren. They are both very active and continually "on the go".


