

**NOTABLE ALUMNI CORNER . . .****DON PAYNE (Class of 1946)**

Looking back, it seems certain that the future of Don Payne had been preordained. In 1941, Don's family moved from Long Island, NY to Las Vegas, where as an 11-year-old, Don gained first-hand experience in the media game as a newsboy hawking papers on the corner of Fremont and Second Streets. After graduating from LVHS, and attending UNR in 1947, he returned to Las Vegas, honing his skills in sales, management and advertising. Don joined the North Las Vegas Jaycees, holding offices of secretary-treasurer of the N.L.V. Chamber of Commerce Executive Association, as president and State Jaycee Board director, and in 1957 was named their Man of the Year for distinguished service. In 1961, following several years in radio, advertising and public relations, Don was named Vice-President of Durk Advertising Agency, handling newspapers, radio, TV, magazines and billboards. In 1964 he joined the Las Vegas News Bureau as a staff writer marketing travel to Las Vegas. Don was



named bureau manager in 1969. Under his leadership the News Bureau would experience phenomenal growth far beyond regional borders to play the preeminent role in promoting Las Vegas to the world. As a member of the Society of American Travel Writers (SATW) Don was instrumental in groundbreaking promotional events such as hosting the SATW annual convention in 1969, and conceiving the Sun Corner, USA program, attracting international visitors to Las Vegas. Sun Corner, USA was comprised of four southwest city areas: Las Vegas, Palm Springs, Long Beach and San Diego. Working with international airlines, Don and the Sun Corner team were flown to participating cities in Europe, Asia, South America, Australia, New Zealand, and the Far East. Don and the airlines would co-host functions with travel journalists in each city he visited. In turn, the airlines agreed to bring those journalists back into the Sun Corner cities to be hosted for two days; where in Las Vegas, the News Bureau and hotels provided them with new material to develop stories and photos on Las Vegas. Their many stories resulted in an upsurge of new world travelers to Las Vegas, as well as several large coffee table books being printed and sold worldwide describing Las Vegas and the wide variety of area attractions available to visitors.

SATW membership allowed Don to make long-lasting professional relationships with North America's premier travel journalists publicizing the Las Vegas and Southern Nevada area. The News Bureau's working relationship with the major hotel publicity departments also allowed Don to give them information as to those journalists and photographers who were or were not justified for comps at their hotels, and who would be producing legitimate stories and photos. Publicity efforts were not confined to the hotel and entertainment areas on the Strip, but encompassed Lake Mead's fishing, boating and camping activities, Hoover Dam, Red Rock Canyon, Valley of Fire, as well as the Grand Canyon. Don worked with major movie producers, assisting in identifying, arranging locations, logistics, and necessary aspects for filming movies in the Las Vegas area such as "The Professionals", "Stalking Moon", and James Bond's "Diamonds are Forever".

In the early 1970s, Don developed an international reach with Las Vegas publicity by generating travel feature stories and pictures throughout the world, including Europe, Australia, New Zealand, Japan, Mexico, Canada, South America and parts of Southern Asia. This outreach played a principal role in securing Las Vegas as an instantly recognizable travel brand worldwide. All this while managing an elite group of photographers, writers and promoters who would benefit greatly from his leadership and in turn, leave a legacy that may never be matched as the preeminent promoters of Las Vegas. SATW has honored Don with their highest award as a "Marco Polo" lifetime member. In 2007, Don was recognized with the AGA Communications Lifetime Achievement Award for outstanding advertising, public relations, marketing and financial and corporate communications in the gaming – entertainment industry.

Don's professional career would allow him to visit every corner of the world, but at the end of the day, his heart and home is here in Las Vegas, where he continues to live and donate his time to worthwhile causes. Above all, he has proven to be a loyal friend, a devoted mentor and dedicated family man who, along with his wife of 52 years, Gretchen Harris, (class of 1953), raised eight children, 21 grandchildren and one great grandchild (along with numerous foreign exchange students). We take great pride in celebrating Don's professional career and even greater admiration for his dedication to improving the lives of those lucky enough to cross the path of his promotional talent.






Clark County Courthouse - 1960-2005


