



NOTABLE ALUMNI CORNER . . .**LINA PINJUV SHARP (Class of 1937)**

We would like you to meet Lina Pinjuv Sharp - a truly remarkable lady! Lina is our oldest known living alumni - and as she says, is "only 97 years old"! She has been coming to the Wildcat Reunions every year for many years! She recently renewed her LVHSAA membership—as a LIFETIME member!

She arrived in Las Vegas with her family in 1929. After graduating from LVHS in 1937, she attended the University of Nevada in Reno, completed a two-year normal program, and was certified as a school teacher.



Jobs were scarce in cities and towns, so Lina took a job and moved to the Blue Eagle Ranch in Railroad Valley, NV in 1940. She taught about 10 children in the one-room wooden school, grades one through eight. After a year she married rancher Jim Sharp, a grandson of Henry Sharp, who had immigrated to the United States from England and settled in Nevada in the late 1860s.

After teaching at the Blue Eagle Ranch, Currant, Duckwater and Tonopah for 45 years, Lina is now retired and still living at Blue Eagle, about 120 miles east of Tonopah. She has 5 daughters, 9 grandchildren and 5 great-grandchildren. Lina says she never sits still and enjoys reading, doing crossword puzzles and making quilts. She loves to travel and has visited all the places she read about and wanted to see except Timbuktu, an actual city in the African country of Mali!

We love you Lina! Thank you for your support of the LVHSAA, and we look forward to seeing you at many more Wildcat Reunions!!





WILLIAM ALLEN KAERCHER (Class of 1968)



Allen was born and raised in Las Vegas. He earned his Bachelor of Science degree in business insurance administration from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas. He is the President of Kaercher Insurance in Las Vegas. He has over 40 years of experience in development and implementation of risk management programs, specializing in risk control programs for a diverse range of clients, including hospitality/gaming accounts, public entities, healthcare facilities, airports, hotel/casinos and other large, complex accounts. He helped develop the first Owner Controlled Insurance Program and assisted with implementation of the first Self Insured Workers Compensation program in Nevada with the risk managers of Summa Corporation and MGM Grand. The result was the creation of laws that are still in effect today in the State of Nevada.



Allen devotes a great deal of his time to numerous community organizations including the Blind

Center of Nevada, After School All Stars and Southern Nevada Water Authority. JILL LEONE (LVHS Faculty, Retired)



Ms. Leone attended high school in Rahway, New Jersey. She earned a BA in Spanish and Latin American Area Studies from the American University in Washington, DC and the Universidad Nacional Autonoma de Mexico in Mexico City. She earned a second BA and a Master's degree in Education at UNLV. She started teaching at LVHS, 7th Street campus, in 1983. She transferred to the East Sahara campus in 1993 and retired at the end of the 2016 school year. She taught English and Reading at both schools, primarily for students struggling to pass the Nevada High School Proficiency Examinations in Reading and Writing. Because of her commitment to her students, she also spent countless hours tutoring after-school, Saturdays, and summers for the state proficiency exams. She was an advisor for the International Club for 13 years and English Department Chair for 18 years. She also worked with RPDP (Research and Professional Development) and UNLV for 6 years doing teacher training and professional development and was a member of the State Department of Education Bias Review Committee for 15 years in Reno. She was a

member of the Testing Committee, the School Improvement Team and the school's accreditation teams through all the accreditation processes over the years. Jill has no children, but has 14 nieces and nephews thanks to her twin sister! She loves to spend as much time as possible visiting her family and friends in New Jersey and also in Mexico, where she lived and studied during her youth. 2016 WILDCAT REUNION

We had a total of 548 attendees, including alumni and guests. Attendees came from all corners of the continental U.S. (including Arizona, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Massachusetts, Maryland, Mississippi, New Mexico, New York, North Carolina, Oregon, Texas, Utah and Washington) plus Mexico. We had attendees from classes of 1937 through 2016 – a 79 year span! Our oldest alumni attendees were Lina Pinjuv Sharp (class of 1937) and Nancy Marriott Austin (class of 1939). Our youngest attendees were two of our scholarship winners from 2016 (Alejandro Aguayo-Flores and Edgar Sepulveda). Our DJ, Brian Mesaric, is from the class of 2003.

We honored the classes of 1946 through 1950 and had 31 alumni attendees from those classes. Although the majority of attendees were from the 50's through the 70's, it appears the word is getting around to the "younger" classmates about how much fun everyone had and what a great opportunity it is to see not only your classmates, but those from other classes as well! And everyone commented on how great the food was!

The program began with the entrance of the 147 member LVHS marching band, followed by LVHS cheerleaders who led attendees in a few yells! The band performed "Viva Las Vegas", and the LVHS Spectrum singing and dance group performed "September".

Congratulations to the class of 1966, celebrating their 50th reunion. They had the most attendees – a total of 91. Class of 1956, celebrating their 60th reunion, had the second highest attendance with 57.



Congratulations to the Class of 1965! They won our Membership Challenge for the second year in a row!! They had a total of 62 alumni association members, beating the class of 1956 by only 5! Their class was presented with the "revolving" trophy, champagne and candy and now has a new little wildcat named Elvira, who will join last year's wildcat Elvee on his worldwide travels during the next year!

Kae Jones Bogdanovich (class of 1956) was presented the "Outstanding Alumni of the Year" award for her on-going support and help over the years. Kae was on the LVHSAA board for 8 years and has served on the Wildcat Reunion Committee for 9 years and is always willing to help whenever asked. Congratulations Kae!



We have an alumni database with almost 5500 alumni names and current addresses, which is used for the mailing of the flyer for the annual Wildcat Reunion. We never give out any information from this database to anyone without permission and it is **NEVER** used for any other purpose. When we do the annual mailing, we get a lot of address updates from the post office and alumni, so our data is as current as possible. We have found that our mailings by "snail mail", rather than email or Facebook, are much more successful, as there is no way to know when people change their email addresses, and those that don't use email are not left out. We will be happy to provide the contact (and keeper of class names and addresses) for each class with the mailing list that we have. We have contacts for classes through 1979, but don't have many for classes of 1980 and after. We have a lot of people each year that say they weren't even aware of the Wildcat Reunion or LVHSAA, so we need your help to reach more alumni! For the last 8 years, the Las Vegas High School Alumni Association has been awarding scholarships to LVHS graduating seniors who plan on attending UNLV or CSN. To date we have awarded 41 students a total of \$75,000, including 5 scholarships totaling \$14,000 this year. Our applicants come from very diverse backgrounds, and though their economic conditions may be difficult, they are all students of high achievement. Many have told us how their college experience has broadened their horizons.

We are always interested in ways to increase the value of our scholarship dollar, and all monies donated to our scholarship fund go directly to our students. We are hoping to increase our scholarship amounts to keep up with increase in college costs.

WHAT BEING A PART OF THE LVHSAA BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEANS TO ME

Nine years ago a small group of people gathered at the old school on 7th Street to form an alumni association for Las Vegas High School. Our main goal was to preserve the old campus and related memories, and to provide scholarships for students at the new campus. **Our scope has broadened to include so much more.** The new campus on East Sahara is considered a "Title I" school and has a high percentage of students from low-income families. Besides our scholarship program, we help students on a personal level by providing bus passes for those students that live out of the district or are involved in extra-curricular activities and don't have transportation available after normal school hours, by providing athletic uniforms and shoes, caps and gowns for graduating seniors who cannot afford them - and much more! We have also assisted the Math and Theater Departments with needed equipment, and helped students with funding to attend the Yearbook Camp and the "Close-Up" program which sends students on 8 day trip to New York, Boston, Philadelphia, and Washington D.C. to witness the governmental process in action by meeting with federal legislators and other policy makers, engage in substantive discussions, and visit national monuments.

In addition, we have formed a close working relationship with the Las Vegas Academy that occupies our old campus. We sponsor an annual art competition for students that includes a specific category of depictions of aspects of the old campus itself, plus we built a Senior Squares monument and donated a display cabinet to have LVHS memorabilia available for viewing by LVHS alumni at the Academy. We want to ensure that their students have an appreciation of the campus and its historic significance.

None of these accomplishments would have been possible without the dedicated efforts of our Board of Directors. They selflessly give of their time to all of these efforts as well as the multiple parades in which our roaring Wildcat float has participated, Homecoming activities and the new campus and the annual Wildcat Reunion.

As a member of the board for the last seven years, I have enjoyed seeing all of the growth of our organization and have felt rewarded to have been able to participate. We need new members with fresh ideas to accomplish even more. Please consider joining us. Come and be part of it - its easier than you think and more rewarding than you know!
