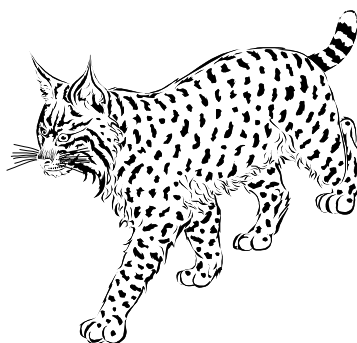

Your Las Vegas High School Alumni Association has had a **great** 2017 - thanks to you - our **great** alumni! We were able to award a record number of

8 scholarships, totaling \$16,000, to LVHS graduates and have raised almost \$20,000 for future scholarships. 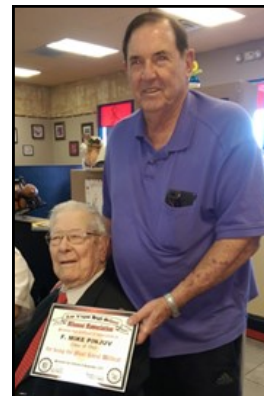
NOTABLE ALUMNI CORNER . . .**F. MIKE PINJUV (Class of 1942)**

One of eight children, F. Mike Pinjuv was born in 1924 in a house in Las Vegas, on E. Ogden Street between 7th and 8th Streets. His family built the house in 1921. The front of the house was the "Pinjuv Cash Grocery" store, which is where, Mike says, he learned to count money!

After graduating from LVHS, Mike was drafted in April, 1943 and spent almost 3 years in the U.S. Army. He was sent to Europe and spent two years in England, France and Germany. He came home at the end of 1945 and went to work for M. J. Christensen and became a Registered Jeweler with the American Gem Society. He then had an offer to be an agent for State Farm Insurance. He started part-time, working out of his home, and then shared an office with two other agents until he opened his own office. He retired on December 31, 2015, after 62 years, and says he is now enjoying "just goofing off".

Mike married Beverly Ann Freeland in 1952. They celebrated their 65th wedding anniversary this year – on October 18th! They have 9 children, 11 grandchildren, and one great-grandchild with another due in March, 2018.

Mike, now 93, was awarded the **"Most Loyal Wildcat"** award this year by the LVHSAA. He has only missed a couple of the annual Wildcat Reunions since they were started by Bill "Wildcat" Morris (class of 19xx) in 1978. He has been a founding lifetime members of the LVHSAA since its inception in 2008.

The 2017 Wildcat Reunion was a big success! We had 467 attendees, including alumni and guests, from all corners of the U.S., plus one attendee from Mexico and one who came all the way from China. We had attendees from classes of 1937 through 2017 - an 80 year span!!

"Once a Wildcat, Always a Wildcat" awards were presented to our oldest attendee, **Lina Pinjuv Sharp** (class of 1937), and to our second oldest attendee, **Nancy Marriott Austin**, class of 1939. Our youngest attendees were 2017 scholarship winners **Gwyneth Fernandez**, **Ana Galilea-Flores** and **Alexandra Salvatierra**. We were also pleased to have **Alejandro Aguayo-Flores**, a 2016 scholarship winner, plus **Jolene Mitchell**, **Susan Thornton** and four members of the Las Vegas Academy Student Council in attendance.

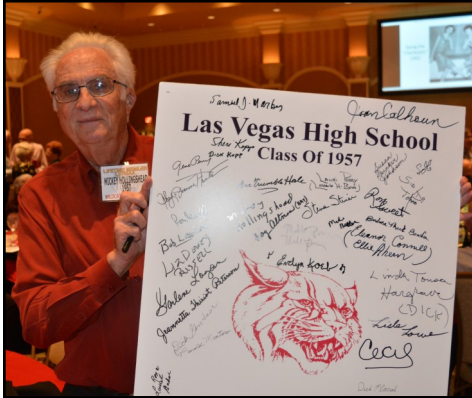

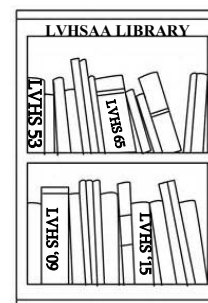

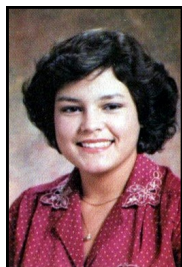
2017 Veterans Day Parade

PRESERVATION OF THE "OLD" LAS VEGAS HIGH SCHOOL CAMPUS (NOW THE LAS VEGAS ACADEMY)

Latest update concerning the restoration of the LVHS original campus - There has been lots of speculation concerning the restoration and continued use of the old Las Vegas High School Campus as well as the design and construction of new additions to the Las Vegas Academy Campus.

I attended a meeting recently at CCSD headquarters with one of the Trustees and other well-known LVHS alumni. It became clear after much discussion that the \$25,000,000 that has been directed toward the repair and upgrading for our original campus is the total and only amount available for construction at the campus for the next 10 years. The planning that the Las Vegas Academy is currently doing for the expansion of the campus has no CCSD funds available now or for the next 10 years for that construction.



Where does this leave us and our original campus? From supposition, apparently the only work that will be done on our campus for the next 10 years is the upgrading, maintenance and repair of our existing buildings. It appears that our campus will remain largely intact at least for the next 10 years.

SCHOLARSHIPS

For the last 9 years, the Las Vegas High School Alumni Association has been awarding scholarships to LVHS graduating seniors who plan on attending a Southern Nevada college. To date we have awarded 49 students a total of \$91,000. Our applicants come from very diverse backgrounds, and though their economic conditions may be difficult, they are all students of high achievement. Many have told us how their college experience has broadened their horizons and has had a positive impact on their future lives. All monies donated to our scholarship fund go directly to our students. We are hoping to increase our scholarship amounts each year to keep up with increases in college costs.
